Cultural Awareness Training

Mirri Mirri offers two Cultural Awareness Training options to increase your understanding of First Nations Peoples and cultures.

Foundational

Our foundational workshop is an introductory session designed for participants who have limited knowledge of First Nations Peoples, histories and cultures.

Key topics include:

- Acknowledgement and Welcome to Country
- First Nations people and culture
- Kinship
- Connection to Country
- Dates of significance
- Appropriate terminology

Advanced

Our advanced workshop is designed for participants who have a baseline understanding of First Nations Peoples, histories and cultures.

Key topics include

- Unconscious bias
- Colonisation
- The Protection Era
- The Stolen Generations
- Trauma & Trauma informed care
- Inclusive work environments

Our 10 years plus experience enables us to tailor our workshops to meet your organisational requirements. We offer face to face and virtual options with a maximum of 40 participants per workshop.

Gadigal



Gadigal land lies at the heart of Sydney's CBD.

During this guided tour, you will visit culturally significant sites, engage in team challenges, and uncover the stories, history and traditions of Aboriginal people. Join us for an urban exploration that blends learning, teamwork and connection to Country in Sydney's living cityscape.

Cammeraygal



Cammeraygal land invites you to connect with nature and culture.

During this scenic bushland walk along the Garadi 'Black Cockatoo' track, you will explore native plants, bush tucker, and participate in cultural activities including weaving, fire-making and spear throwing. Join us for a hands-on experience that brings Country, knowledge and community together.

Redfern



Redfern is the heartbeat of Aboriginal Activism in Australia.

During this walking tour, you will visit significant locations in Redfern, link past to present and connect with Aboriginal people and services. Join us for this urbanised approach to walking on country.

eLearning

Narrated by Paul Sinclair, Director of Education, the Mirri Mirri eLearning uses powerful storytelling to explore Aboriginal culture, European arrival, the Stolen Generations and Aboriginal activism.

The course takes approximately 120 minutes and is an in-depth exploration of the following topics:

- Cultural Practices
- Aboriginal People
- Torres Strait Islander People
- European Arrival
- The Stolen Generations
- Activism

Youth Programs

Our Warada program is designed specifically for First Nations Female high school students and partnering organisations.

Our youth and leadership programs involve Mirri Mirri providing facilitators to deliver leadership and cultural workshops to young people.

Warada Program

The Warada Program provides a unique cross-cultural learning opportunity for your staff and female First Nations students.

Facilitated by Mirri Mirri, the full day program involves your workplace hosting female high school students, providing one to one female mentors and participating in cultural and leadership activities.

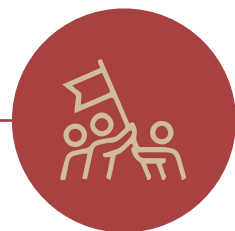
